MOAR is a member of The United We Stand for Public Health Coalition, which is asking for revenues versus cuts for all MA Department of Public Health Services. As a MA Coalition for Addiction Services Member, and newly formed Campaign for Prevention, Treatment, and Recovery

- We also ask that the sales tax exemption on alcohol beverages be repealed.
- We want the revenues to be managed in a Substance Abuse Health Protection fund by The MA Department of Public Health for addiction prevention, treatment, and recovery support services across all public services agencies. In this economic downturn it is important to have both funding from the traditional budget and what would be The Substance Abuse Health Protection Fund, which could amount to \$115 million. In states, where this measure exists, underage drinking has decreased.
