## A Peer Recovery Group for Parents Navigating the DCF and Criminal Justice Systems

The **PARENt (Parents in Addiction Recovery Engaging Together) Project**, a **MOAR initiative**, provides no-cost, specialized, culturally-reflective peer recovery support services (PRSS) to help parents who are trying to navigate the addiction recovery, Department of Children and Families (DCF), and criminal justice systems.

### Eligible Individuals Must:

- Live in Hampden or Worcester County
- Have a low-income
- Be in early recovery from addiction, and
- Have recent child welfare or justice involvement (or be at risk of child removal)

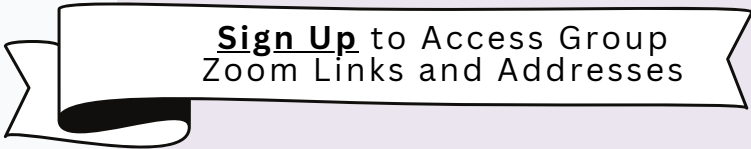
